Psychoeducational groups facilitated by an LCSW.



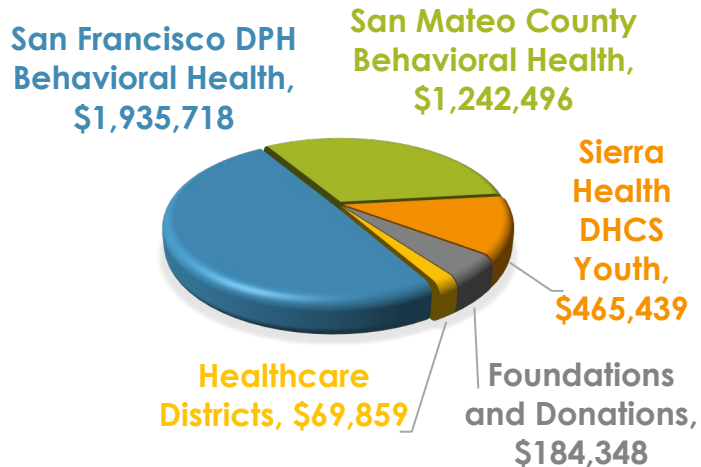
LatinXCEL Fund for Latino Leadership Development and Community Action Grant for Mental Health Individual Therapy Sessions.



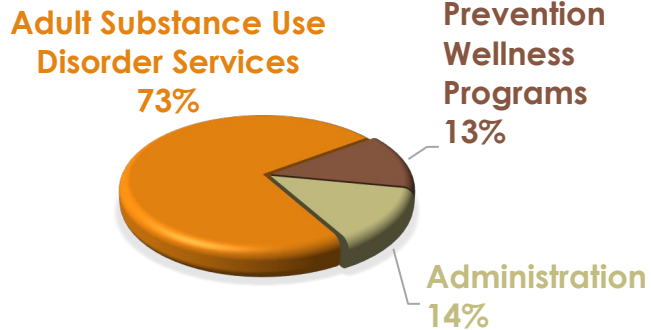
